OBJECTIVE

For this series of roadshows, MAN brings some of their vehicles to different locations across the UK to meet with existing customers. This provides customers with the opportunity to ask questions, see the new range of vehicles for themselves, and compare across the range, so they can purchase the best-suited vehicle.

SOLUTION

Our initial objective was to secure five roadshow locations across the UK, with the aim of reaching a wide pool of customers. However, following thoughtful consideration, the client decided to reduce to three locations. Venues secured were at Haydock Park near Manchester, NAEC Stoneleigh near Coventry, and Pavilions of Harrogate, allowing buyers from different parts of the UK could attend at least one.

We didn't just stop at securing the optimal locations; we took care of everything else too. We managed the project from end-to-end, including supplier liaison, budget management, arranged final details to ensure everything ran smoothly. Our goal was to make things easy for both buyers and sellers, showing how much we cared about making the roadshows successful.
